Dear Parent/Care Giver,

Wyndham Central College is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of Wyndham Central College's parent payment arrangements for 2021.

Laptops - Wyndham Central College has opted for a co-contribution program (using DET guidelines) for the student's laptops, as the ability to support Bring Your Own Devices (BYOD) is difficult and limiting. Students in year 7 and year 10 are offered a new Dell laptop on a three year lease-to-own basis and allows the ability to utilise eBooks (digital text books) in years 7 to 10. Both of these items (laptop and eBooks) are optional and a family may wish to purchase text books if preferred and a list of books is available from Administration.

Essential Items – Wyndham Central College are items, activities and services that are essential to support student learning of the standard curriculum. These are items that the school considers essential for all students and include items the student takes possession of. Parent may choose to provide the items themselves that meet with the requirements where appropriate or applicable.

Optional Items - Wyndham Central College makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all families. Optional items are designed to broaden and enhance the school experience for your child, which may include various elective items or activities that are additional to the delivery of the standard curriculum.

Voluntary Contributions
